

Bequest Information Sheet

Bequests help us plan more effectively for the future and secure our work now. If you are considering leaving a bequest for Allowah Disability Support Services, please read the information on this fact sheet.

Making a will is an important thing to do – it gives you the opportunity to safeguard what is important to you and how you want your assets to be managed.

Including a gift to your favourite community group is one way to continue your support. It is important to see your legal advisor before you do so. If after seeking legal advice, you have decided to leave a bequest to Allowah, you may find the following words helpful for inclusion in your will.

For your gift to Allowah we recommend the following wording for your legal adviser's consideration:

"I give to THE PRESBYTERIAN CHURCH (NEW SOUTH WALES) PROPERTY TRUST free of testamentary charges and duties, specifically for ALLOWAH DISABILITY SUPPORT SERVICES for general purposes,

the whole of my estate, OR

_____ % of my estate, OR

the residue of my estate (OR ___ % of the residue of my estate), OR

the sum of \$ _____, OR

my units/shares in _____ Trust/Ltd, OR

my real property situated at [insert street address] having the title reference _____,

The receipt of the treasurer, secretary or public officer for the time being is an absolute discharge to my executor."
